POLICY ON APPROVED CANADIAN MIDWIFERY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

In the Midwifery Act and Regulations, one of the prerequisites to active-practising licensure is graduation from an approved Canadian university midwifery education program. The Midwifery Regulatory Council of Nova Scotia (MRCNS) recognizes the midwifery education programs of the following institutions:

1. Laurentian University (Sudbury, ON)
2. McMaster University (Hamilton, ON)
3. Ryerson University (Toronto, ON)
4. Université du Québec à Trois Rivières (Trois Rivières, QC)
5. University of British Columbia (Vancouver, BC)
6. Mount Royal University (Calgary, AB)
