

**POLICY ON CONTINUING COMPETENCY IN
CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION**

Registered midwives with an active practising (clinical) licence or a provisional (clinical) licence must be certified every two years in cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Proof of certification will be required for initial registration and annual renewal of registration.

The minimum required standard is completion of the Canadian Heart and Stroke Foundation's Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers (C) course.
