

POLICY ON CONTINUING COMPETENCE IN NEONATAL RESUSCITATION

Registered midwives with an active-practising (clinical) or provisional (clinical) licence must be certified annually in neonatal resuscitation. Proof of certification will be required for initial registration and annual licence renewal.

The minimum required standard is successful completion of the Canadian Pediatric Society's Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP), Levels 1-9, including tracheal intubation.

Midwives who are NRP instructors will be considered to have met the above requirement when proof is provided of:

- a) current NRP (Levels 1-9) instructor status; and
- b) teaching at least one NRP course in the preceding 12 months.
