MIDWIFERY REGULATORY COUNCIL OF NOVA SCOTIA

POLICY ON APPROVING NEW CANADIAN MIDWIFERY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Midwifery Regulatory Council may approve a Canadian midwifery education program without undertaking its own approval process as long as it meets the following criteria:

- 1. The program has been approved by another Canadian midwifery regulatory body for registration in that province or territory;
- 2. The program or regulatory body is able to provide a report on either the regulatory body's review or internal review of the program;
- 3. The report contains information that is sufficient and satisfactory to the Council.
