



MRCNS staff and the Council have been busy completing action items mandated by the Nova Scotia Department of Health and Wellness in regards to Quality Assuarance.

MRCNS was selected by the DHW to participate in a pilot survey of QA policies along with other health regulatory bodies. The survey highlighted some areas which require action, and MRCNS has responded. For example, we have created more tools to help both the public and our registrants navigate the complaints process.
